### Axiom Terminateair HP

Forget the ridiculous name (if you can), this pump from Axiom is great for the sensible cyclist. No, it is not super-light nor compact, but it will certainly do its job when required. It's always good to see a flexible nozzle on hand pumps to almost eliminate the risk of bending a tube's valve when inflating.

The Terminateair does not have a 'smart valve' that automatically converts it from presta to schrader but a quick twist of an indexed barrel at the head will do this in an instant. The bracket is very firm and there is a strap to help secure the pump to your bike and give it few opportunities to rattle loose.
